Hardanger embroidery is named after Hardanger, Norway. The Hardanger area is known for the Hardangerfjord, the Hardangervidde mountain plateau, and the fantastic fruit tree blossoming in the spring time.

The different areas have their own hardanger designs. The embroidery is a cut work of magnificent designs. This year we will be studying about the area and the different stitches and designs.

This method of embroidery when finished is heirloom quality. The only hard part of hardanger is the word "hard". We will start with a small piece and move up to larger ones as you are ready.
