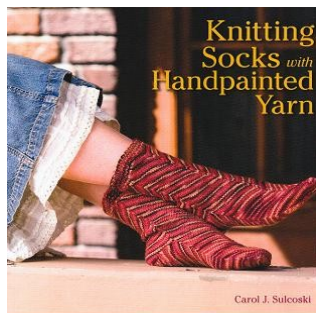
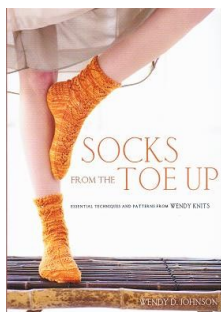

## News from Florence's Attic for Needlework fanatics & S.W.A.N.'s

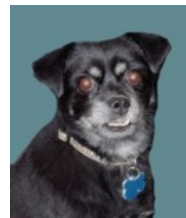
Dear Stitching Friends,

**Sock Workshop**  
**Sat. February 27<sup>th</sup>**  
**1:00-3:30**

Make a pair of socks in one of these methods.  
1)make 1 sock on double points and circular needle..  
2)make 2 socks at the same time on double points and 2 circular needles.  
3)Make one sock at a time using double points and a 12” circular needle.  
Choose between top-up or top-down methods.  
You must know how to knit with double point needles and circular needles. You must also need to be able to read instructions.
